

FISU Shooting Sport regulations (Technical Regulations)

5.1 General Terms

The Shooting Sport event shall be organised in accordance with the most recent technical rules of the International Shooting Sport Federation (ISSF) unless otherwise stated by FISU. In the event of a disagreement in the interpretation of these rules, the English text shall be regarded as authoritative.

The program and duration of competitions are fixed by the FISU in agreement with the Organising Committee and the CTI. The competitions shall last five (5) days and include the following events:

Rifle discipline

Events for Men

10m Air Rifle Men (60 shots)

50m Rifle 3 Positions Men (3x40 shots)

Events for Women

10m Air Rifle Women (60 shots)

50m Rifle 3 Positions Women (3x40 shots)

Mixed Team Air Rifle

Pistol discipline

Events for Men

10m Air Pistol Men (60 shots)

25m Rapid Fire Pistol Men (60 shots)

Events for Women

10m Air Pistol Women (60 shots)

25m Pistol Women (30 + 30 shots)

Mixed Team Air Pistol

Shotgun discipline

Events for Men

Skeet Men (125 Target)

Trap Men (125 Target)

Events for Women

Skeet Women (125 Target)

Trap Women (125 Target)

Mixed Team Trap

Each country may enter a maximum of thirty-nine (39) persons: thirty-three (33) competitors and six (6) officials.
